



# Northern Ireland Sustainable Energy Programme April 2024 to March 2025

#### Introduction

Welcome to the Northern Ireland Sustainable Energy Programme (NISEP). NISEP is all about helping homes and businesses in Northern Ireland become more energy efficient while also reducing carbon emissions.

**How We Help:** NISEP is administered on behalf of the Utility Regulator by Energy Saving Trust. Scheme Managers registered under NISEP comply with terms and conditions set out by the Utility Regulator and are responsible for scheme delivery.

Timeframe: The NISEP year runs from 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025, or until funds are exhausted.

Who is eligible for the programme? There are a few things to consider, such as your income, where you live, and/or if you are a homeowner, private tenant, or non-domestic/commercial property. This guide will summarise each scheme's eligibility.

Check out the contents table below for an overview and get in touch with the relevant Scheme Manager who will take you through the application process. Separate terms and conditions may apply to each scheme.

There is also a useful glossary at the end of this document, to help explain some of the measures that NISEP offers.

NB: Most schemes have their own set of vulnerability criteria or income thresholds to identify qualifying households. In general, NISEP schemes are targeted at households who do not qualify for assistance from other government schemes such as Affordable Warmth. Please note, where demand is higher than funding available, a vulnerability matrix may be used to prioritise applicants.

Customers in areas where natural gas is not available, and have no existing central heating, a solid fuel fire or electric room heater (which is used as the main heat source), can only convert to other forms of electric heating.

Flat roof properties are ineligible for loft insulation.

For an Insulation Scheme, if insulation is only required in the extension of a property i.e. the remainder of the house is up to current standard, the insulation of the extension of the property is not eligible for NISEP funding.

# Glossary

Measure	Description	
Loft Insulation	Loft insulation is a layer of fibre that is rolled out in the roof space to cut down heat loss through the roof. A quarter of heat is lost through the roof	
	if not insulated. Insulating your loft or attic is an effective way to reduce heat loss and reduce your heating bills.	
Cavity Wall Insulation	About a third of all the heat lost in an uninsulated home escapes through the walls. By properly insulating cavity walls, you will save energy and	
	cut costs off your heating bill. Many cavity walls can be insulated by injecting insulation material into the cavity from the outside.	
Solid Wall Insulation	If your home was built before the 1920s, its external walls are probably solid walls rather than cavity walls. Solid walls have no gap, so they can't	
	be filled with cavity wall insulation. Instead, internal wall insulation is done by fitting rigid insulation boards to the wall, or by building a stud wall	
	filled in with insulation material such as mineral wool fibre. Or External wall insulation is carried out which involves fixing a layer of insulation	
	material to the wall, then covering it with a special type of render (plasterwork) or cladding. The finish can be smooth, textured, painted, tiled,	
	panelled, pebble-dashed, or finished with brick slips.	
LED Bulbs	Energy efficient lighting helps lower electricity bills and carbon dioxide emissions, all without reducing the quality of light in our homes.

	functionality than conventional heating controls. Some models can enable you to use your smart phone to control the heating when you're not	
	at home. Others can learn your habits and adjust the settings to match, by tracking where you are using your smartphone location it will turn on	
	the heating system to heat the house/hot water in time for your return.	
Hot Water Tank Jacket	Insulating water tanks reduces the amount of heat lost through the tank, so you spend less money heating water up, and hot water stays hotter	
	for longer.	
Chimney Draught	A chimney draught excluder is a handy device fitted inside the chimney or around the fireplace, to stop the warm air going up and the cold	
Excluder	draughts coming back down and into the room.
